AUTHORIZATION FOR TREATMENT OF MINOR

I, the undersigned, understand and acknowledge that reasonable efforts will be made to contact the parent/guardian in case of an emergency, and, if possible, before any medical treatment is administered. In the event of an emergency or if the parents cannot be notified, I hereby give permission to the Program Leader or the WorldStrides staff to secure treatment for my child. If necessary, this includes contacting and engaging with medical service providers, who are then authorized to perform such treatments as deemed medically necessary. I further give my permission for WorldStrides staff to have access to medical records relating to any treatment contemplated or received by my child and to provide such information, as necessary, to health insurance carriers. I understand that I may be responsible for all costs associated with the provision of emergency medical services or treatment.

WorldStrides is not a medical service provider, and its employees are not trained to render medical care or treatment, nor does WorldStrides control the selection, hiring, training, or supervision of the staff of any medical service provider, including, but not limited to, The George Washington University Medical Faculty Associates (GWMFA). The Doctors on Call program is independently operated by GWMFA and WorldStrides disclaims all liability arising out of the rendering or failure to render any medical, dental, surgical, nursing or therapeutic service of treatment, or from the furnishing or failure to furnish any drugs, medications, medical or dental supplies or appliances, or to any claim you may have related to screening, selection, hiring, retention, training, instruction or supervision of any employee, or any other person or organization engaged in providing or failing to provide such services.

WorldStrides cannot be responsible for accommodating any food allergies, requirements or restrictions and is not responsible for any problems associated with the same. All issues with regard to food and drink, including allergies, requirements and restrictions are the sole responsibility of the participant.

In the event of any emergencies during the trip, the undersigned hereby grants authority to be exercised at the discretion of the Program Leader or chaperone to dispense over-the-counter medication.

The undersigned further acknowledges and understands that WorldStrides is not a medical service provider, and hereby releases WorldStrides from all liability related to any provision of, or failure to provide, any medical services.
